



PROJECT EMPLOYEE TITLES, JOB CODES & SUGGESTED SALARY GUIDELINES

The tables in this document may be used to help determine an employee's Research Foundation, CUNY (RFCUNY) title, job code, grade, and salary. The actual salary is subject to availability of funds, complexity and duration of the project, sponsor requirements, or on the required qualifications for the position. Complete job descriptions are available as a separate PDF File.

Notes

- All appointments of employees assigned to either salary category 11 or 12 must bear the approval of the Foundation President.
- Since certain federal restrictions may apply, individuals receiving total compensation over \$120,000, regardless of funding sources, must secure prior approval from RFCUNY before any appointment is made.
- Graduate Students are not considered employees of RFCUNY under the National Labor Relations Act.
- Graduate Research Assistants must be full time CUNY doctoral students on grant funding.
- Before assigning an hourly salary in excess of \$96.38 an hour, you must submit written justification to RFCUNY Human Resources.
- Seasonal /Recreational employees working at a distinct organized camp are exempt from overtime, annual leave, and minimum wage requirements.
