General Description

A position is IMMEDIATELY available for a full-time research assistant in a neuroscience laboratory in the CUNY School of Medicine. The laboratory studies development and repair of the motor systems after injury in animals. The successful applicant will assist with animal surgeries, data analysis, and engage in routine lab management. The successful applicant must have excellent organizational skills and be able to keep accurate record and notes.

Key general skills:

- Familiarity and experience working with rodents.
- Ability to work with a team of scientists and students
- Ability to keep well-organized records
- Knowledge of basic computing, including the ability to work with Microsoft Excel.
- Willing to be trained to perform laboratory tasks in a safe and timely fashion
- Experience managing a mouse colony—including breeding, weaning, and genotyping—is preferred.

Other Duties

There are 4 principal duties:

1. Management of a small mouse colony and genotyping
2. Assist as needed during animal surgeries and animal experiments. This also includes helping with pre- and post-surgical care, and maintaining surgical records.
3. Assist in training animals to perform motor tasks.
4. Data analysis, including computer-based microscopy
5. Aspects of lab management; including: supply ordering, checking inventory of supplies, etc.
