- **Mastery of Subject Matter:** The Basic Skills Instructor will demonstrate at least 2 years of high-level competency and success in working with populations needing remediation in an educational setting, preferably in a college/university environment.
- Evaluation of Student Learning: The Basic Skills Instructor, in collaboration with the Hemodialysis Instructors and Coordinator, will ensure that continuous evaluation of student learning and retention is implemented, and will write regular reports documenting students' progress and challenges.

Other Duties

- Prepare Lesson Plans for tutoring and teaching sessions.
- Support student progress through appropriate instructional methodologies, demonstrating a student-

centered approach.

- Work in close collaboration with the Hemodialysis Instructors and Coordinator on the monitoring and evaluation of student progress.
- Maintain student records, including attendance, grading, progress reports and student files.
- Attend meetings and assist in additional program duties and responsibilities, as needed.
