# **General Description**

### **MISSION**

As part of the Career Success portfolio overseen by the University Dean of Continuing Education and Workforce Programs, CUNY is seeking to hire a Sector Innovation Specialist in the Health Care sector, an industry that is important to the NYC economy, to act as a connection point between industry and CUNY's 24 colleges.

#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Sector Innovation Specialists play a pivotal role in the private sector employer engagement strategy for CUNY's university-wide Career Success initiatives. Specialists will work directly with employers in key industries to create true partnership between CUNY colleges and Greater NYC's vibrant business community. Through these connections, employers will have access to a variety of career development engagement activities including guest lecturing, networking events, curriculum support and feedback, and the development of hiring plans for internships and full time positions. Specialists will report to the Director of Sector Innovation.

### **Other Duties**

Represent the central access point to the University for industry on behalf of CUNY's colleges and faculty. The Healthcare Sector Innovation Specialists works with the Sector Innovation Team team to elevate CUNY's business engagement and carry out project activities.

- Act as the industry expert and liaison for college staff, employer partners, and Central Office colleagues
- Cultivate a portfolio of high-level industry relationships with key employers in the respective area of focus resulting in multi-faceted partnerships that directly benefit CUNY students.
- Implement a business engagement strategy that includes developing at least 20 anchor employer partners

that actively support CUNY's mission and partner with the university in a variety of ways including hiring CUNY students and graduates as employees and interns

- Increase the University's visibility, and broaden CUNY's footprint within the health care sector in New York City and in other key markets relevant to CUNY students
- Work closely with college partners and other staff to program events for students, college staff, and faculty
- Work with faculty to develop curriculum as appropriate
- Work with career services staff to ensure student preparation aligns with employer needs
- · Attend staff meetings and trainings as required.
- Perform special projects and other duties as assigned.
- Maintain detailed records of engagement activities and track outcomes
- Support the CUNY Career Success Learning Community
