## ANNUAL LEAVE ACCRUAL RATES

These accrual rates are based on a 35 -hour work week and are to be pro-rated for Part-time employees. To determine the amount of leave accrued by Part-time employees, multiply the number of hours worked by the appropriate factor (based on years of service). For example, a Part-time employee with one year of service who works 20 hours per week (40hours per pay period) will accrue 2.31 hours of annual leave per pay period ( 40 hours $\times 0.057692$ hours/hour worked $=2.31$ hours). Over 26 pay periods, a Part-time employee will accrue 60 hours of annual leave.
